**Clinical Training Courses**

**PSY 5000 Clinical Training Orientation, 0 unit --- To be completed during first quarter of enrollment:** Held during week 11 of each quarter; PSY 500AA is a prerequisite to begin Clinical Training. Clinical Training Orientation is required for all first quarter students and any MAP student who has not yet attended it. Students learn about the requirements for the MAP degree, for MFT and LPCC licensure, how to go about finding a training site, what resources are available, and how to use these resources.

**PSY 6230 Personal Psychotherapy, 0 unit:** All Clinical Psychology students are required to participate as a client in personal psychotherapy for a minimum of two academic quarters. Students must complete Form C within the Drop/Add period each quarter in order to receive credit for the course. Please see the Graduate Psychology Program section of the AULA Online Catalog labeled "Personal Psychotherapy Requirement" for detailed information.

**PSY 5000AA Clinical Training Readiness, 0 unit --- Recommended for the third quarter; must be completed prior to Clinical Training:** This is a prerequisite for 90-unit students to begin Clinical Training and is designed to help students in learning about and preparing for the various facets of applying to and securing a clinical training placement. This course assesses students' readiness to enter clinical training and serves as a bridge between introductory, didactic coursework and applied experiences in applied clinical work. Prerequisites: 5000, 5010A, 5410F, 5480 (500, 501A, 541F, 548) Corequisite: 5410G (541G)

**PSY 5000A PERFECT, 0 unit --- Must be completed the quarter prior to beginning Clinical Training:** PERFECT (Pre-Enrollment Requirements for Entering Clinical Training) is a prerequisite to begin Clinical Training and is required for all MAP students to complete one quarter prior to registering for their first Clinical Traineeship. This seminar is the continuation of the information discussed in 5000 and 5000AA (500, 500AA). In the PERFECT seminar, the paperwork required to contact with a training site, to register for Clinical Training academic units, and to track hours for Antioch and the BBS is explained. This seminar is completed via a computer-based tutorial available through Sakai.

**PSY 6200 Applied Psychotherapeutic Techniques (Clinical Training), 1-6 units --- Must be taken at the same time as PSY 6210:** To enroll in PSY 620, please contact the Clinical Training Office and/or the Office of the Registrar to complete required paperwork. The following prerequisites must be completed prior to enrollment for 90u students: 5000A (5010A, 541F, 541G, 548, 531A; 532A is recommended; for 72u students: 500A (501A, 541, 548,)

**PSY 6210 Clinical Training Practicum, 0 unit --- Must be taken at the same time as PSY 6200:** Clinical Practicum is ONLY for students who will be accruing hours at a clinical traineeship during the three month quarter. Students currently earning hours at a clinical site MUST be enrolled in a section of Clinical Practicum in order for any hours to count for AULA or the BBS. This course meets in person and online. **Note: you cannot register for a section of PSY 6210 if the instructor is affiliated with your training site (e.g. Being Alive, AUCC, Colors)**
